COCp-1400-2024

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 20.09.2023 passed in CWP-6549-2021.

2. Perusal of the record shows that vide order dated 20.09.2023 passed in CWP-6549-2021, this Court had appointed Mr. Naresh Gopal Sharma, Advocate, as an Administrator to conduct elections of the Punjab Handball Association. It is not even in dispute that the said process has been completed by the aforesaid Advocate and the result of the said elections has been declared by him. Therefore, the order stands complied with.

3. Although, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the Court Commissioner had not followed the rules relating to the

elections, however, the same would not bring the case of the petitioner within the scope of contempt jurisdiction. If the petitioner is aggrieved against the validity of the process of the elections, he could assail the result of the selection, as well as, the process thereof. However, no contempt qua the order of this Court could be alleged by the petitioner.

4. In view of the above, this Court does not find any merit in the present petition.
5. Dismissed.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
