1. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 23.4.2024, the following order was passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 0428 dated 29.12.2023, registered under Sections 379-B (2), 511, 34 IPC at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been wrongly implicated in the present FIR as the petitioner is known to the complainant and the complainant is inimical towards him. It is further submitted that co-accused, namely, Jinder alias Sagar alias Bhairo has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-10304-2024 (Annexure P-3)

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned State counsel seeks a short accommodation to file reply/status report.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join the

investigation and co-operate fully in the investigation process; and in the event of his arrest, he be released on interim bail, subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

If the Investigating/Arresting Officer does not permit the petitioner to join the investigation, the petitioner would appear before the Illaqa Magistrate, who would then summon the Arresting Officer and direct him to join the petitioner in investigation, in terms of order of this Court.

A copy of the complete paper book be supplied to learned State counsel by the learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

Reply/status report be filed before next date of hearing with an advance copy thereof to counsel opposite.”

2. Today, the learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by SI Gurvinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is fully co-operating with the investigation process and he is not required for any further custodial interrogation.

3. In view of the specific stand taken by the learned State counsel, the present petition is **allowed** and order dated 23.4.2024 is, hereby, made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
