Custody certificate has been placed on record.

By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.34 dated 21.11.2022 registered under Section 21/29 (Act No.61 of 1985) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station State Special Operation Cell, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused – Surender Singh alias Surinder Singh was allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 07.10.2023 in CRM-M-39269 of 2023(O&M). Copy of that order has been placed on record.

On perusal of the order passed by this Court qua co-accused Surender Singh alias Surinder Singh, it is revealed that case of the petitioner is on quite different pedestal inasmuch as 13 kg of heroin was recovered from the possession of petitioner – Bindu Singh alias Binder and Sukhvir alias Kala, which is 52 times more than the threshold from which the commercial category for heroin starts.

Looking into the huge quantity of contraband as recovered from the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to issue any notice to the other party or to grant bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
