This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for directing the official respondents to provide with police protection to the newly married petitioners and not to interfere with the liberty and married life of the petitioner in any manner and further for directing the respondents No.2 and 3 not to register any criminal case against the petitioners or their family members at the instance of respondents No.4 and 5 or any other family members.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioners, feeling aggrieved by the act and conduct of private respondents No.4 and 5, had moved the representation dated 18.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa, to consider and dispose of the

representation dated 18.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ankit Grewal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and submits that the representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.
5. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2- The Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa, to consider and dispose of the representation 18.04.2024 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
7. Disposed of.
