1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.95 dated 09.03.2024, registered under Sections 323, 341, 307, 506, 148 & 149 of IPC, at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.
2. On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed by this Court, whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation with the police.
3. Today, the counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that by virtue of the aforesaid order of interim bail, the petitioner has already joined investigation with the police.
4. the State counsel on instructions from SI Dharam Pal submits that indeed the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.
5. In light of the above, without expressing any opinion on the

merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 22.04.2024 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as are envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. However, it is made clear that petitioner is to join further investigation as and when called to do so by the Investigating Officer.
