Present second petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 279 dated 23.11.2019 under Sections 120-B, 420, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station, Sector 14, Panchkula, District Panchkula alongwith all subsequent proceedings *qua* petitioner.
