1. The present petition has been filed for seeking quashing of impugned order dated 7.11.2023(Annexure P-2), passed by the learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot in FIR No.149 dated 7.8.2021, under Sections 341, 324, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

2. Though the learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to point out any illegality in the order dated 7.11.2023, wherethrough, the petitioner has been declared as a proclaimed offender. However, he submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the learned trial Court concerned, in case adequate protection is granted to him. He further submits that the petitioner was earlier appearing before the learned trial Court concerned, but on account of unavoidable circumstances, he could not cause appearance before the learned trial Court concerned, which led the learned trial Court concerned to pass the impugned order.

3. Since there is no perversity or illegality in the impugned order (supra), therefore, the impugned order is maintained and upheld.

4. However, the petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court within 15 days from today. In case the petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court concerned, within the prescribed time period and move an application for regular bail, the same shall be heard and decided on the same day after giving adequate opportunity to the parties concerned. Till then the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.

5. **Disposed of** accordingly.

6. In case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the learned trial Court concerned within 15 days from today, the interim protection shall be deemed to be *ipso-facto* vacated without any further reference to this Court.
