1. By way of present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, a prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondent No.5.

Upon advance notice, Mr. Athar Ahmed, DAG, Punjab appears on behalf of respondents-State and informs this Court that the present is a pure and simple case of civil nature as an application from the side of respondent No.5 has already been received by the official respondents regarding non-payment of certain amount by the petitioner to him.

Learned State counsel further submits that both the parties shall be called in the office of respondent No.4 and appropriate action shall be taken after hearing them and going through their representations and needful shall be done within a period of 04 weeks from today.
