The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the
Constitution of India, seeking the following reliefs:-

*“i. Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus
summoning the records of the case.*

*ii. Issue a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing
circular No.3 of 2021 dated 21.05.2021 (Annexure P-6)
issued by respondent – Punjab State Power Corporation
Limited.*

*iii. Issue a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing
the advertisement No.CRA-305/24 dated 05.03.2024
(Annexure P-1) issued by respondent – Punjab State Power
Corporation Limited to the extent of infringement upon the
right of the petitioners to apply and be considered for
selection and appointment to the posts of Assistant Sub-
Station Attendant.*

*iv. Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing
the respondent – Punjab State Power Corporation Limited
to adopt the qualifications prescribed under the
unamended Punjab State Electricity Board Technical
Service Class-III Regulations, 1996 (Annexure P-5) in the
present recruitment initiated vide advertisement No.CRA-
305/24 dated 05.03.2024.”*

On receipt of advance copy of writ petition, Mr. Gagneshwar Walia, Advocate, has produced a copy of decision whereby the Board of Directors of Punjab State Power Corporation Limited in their 6th meeting held on 26.02.2021, granted approval for creation of new cadre post of Assistant Sub-Station Attendant (ASSA) along with inclusion of regulations/rules governing the newly created cadre of Assistant Sub-Station Attendant (ASSA) in the related Technical Service Regulations.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to challenge the abovesaid decision/regulations, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
