Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order granting petitioner the extension in service was withdrawn by the respondents, which was impugned in the present writ petition and while issuing notice of motion, the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had stayed the operation of the said impugned order dated 12.05.2022 (Annexure P-7) and as of now, the petitioner has already retired after attaining the age of superannuation, hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such and in case, any of the benefit after the retirement is not paid, petitioner be given liberty to file appropriate representation to the respondents and in case, any such representation is filed, the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioner, the same will be looked into



and an appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
