KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.29 dated 22.2.2024, under Section 379 IPC and under Section 21 of the Mining and Minerals Act, 1957, registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana.

2. On 24.4.2024, this Court had extended the relief of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner and directed him to join the investigation.

3. Despite giving two opportunities, the petitioner did not co-operate with the investigating agency.

4. Faced with the above difficulty, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the relief of pre-arrest bail

and the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the learned trial



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Court concerned and he will be satisfied in case a direction is passed upon the learned trial Court concerned to decide his regular bail application.

5. The instant petition is **dismissed** as not pressed, however, in case the petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court concerned, within ten days from today and move an application for regular bail, the learned trial Court concerned after giving an adequate opportunity of hearing to the parties concerned, shall make an endeavor to decide the same expeditiously.

6. **Disposed of** accordingly.
