The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.

seeking anticipatory bail in FIR mentioned below:-

2. Vide order dated 09.05.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation. Order dated 09.05.2024 is reproduced as under:-

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case along with his son Harjinder Singh alias Moongi. It is further submitted that Harjinder Singh @ Moongi against whom serious allegations are levelled, has surrendered and is taken into custody by the police on 8.5.2024. It is further submitted that the injuries attributed to the present petitioner are found to be simple in nature and the petitioner having no criminal history, is ready to join investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from HC Karam Dem submits that main accused-Harjinder Singh alias Moongi is already arrested in this case and has not refuted the fact that only simple injury is attributed to the present petitioner who is not involved in any other criminal case.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant submits that the weapon used in the commission of the crime by the present petitioner remains to be recovered and that there are serious allegations against the petitioner and prayer is made that the present petition be dismissed.

Admittedly, main accused/Harjinder Singh @ Moongi son of the petitioner is arrested by the police. It also appears that only simple injuries are attributed to the present petitioner as is admitted by the State counsel.

In the given circumstances, the petitioner is hereby directed to join the investigation with the police and in case of arrest, he is to be released on interim bail by the investigating officer/arresting officer to his own satisfaction till the next date fixed in this case. The petitioner is also to abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.

Now be listed on 22.7.2024.”

3. Learned State counsel has not filed status report. She further, on instructions states that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 11.05.2024. Recovery has been effected from the petitioner. Challan has been presented in the Court. His custodial interrogation is not required. No useful purpose would be served by detaining him in custody. In view of the said facts but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.05.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
