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AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Shamsher Singh @Shera has filed petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 257 dated 19.11.2023, under Sections 21(b), 25 and 27 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act') and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that present petitioner has been named by co-accused who alleged that he had purchased contraband from present petitioner. The allegations are false. He has already joined the investigation as per previous order dated 23.04.2024 and he is still ready to join the investigation as and when required.

3. Learned counsel representing State of Punjab on instructions from ASI Rampal, Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar stated that present petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for any other purpose.

4. Considering the aforesaid factual position, petitioner Shamsher Singh @ Shera is not required for any other purpose. He has already joined the investigation in compliance of previous order dated 23.04.2024. Therefore, *interim* bail already granted in favour of petitioner vide order dated 23.04.2024 stands confirmed, subject to conditions as enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. Bail application is accordingly allowed.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
