Reply by way of an affidavit dated 25.04.2024 of Shri Gurdev Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Malerkotla, District Malerkotla has been filed on behalf of respondent- State, as per which on the statement of one Sukhjeet Singh FIR No.35 dated 13.04.2024 under Sections 420, 380 of the IPC was registered at Police Station City-1, Malerkotla against Lakhwinder Singh (husband of the petitioner). Said Lakhwinder Singh was formally arrested on 13.04.2024 and was produced in the Court of learned SDJM, Malerkotla who granted two days police remand. During interrogation, said accused Lakhwinder Singh even suffered disclosure statement under Section 27 of the Evidence Act and got effected the recovery of a scooty used in the crime.

It is evident from the aforesaid reply that husband of the petitioner was not detained illegally and rather he was arrested during investigation of a criminal case as pending against him.

As such, no direction is required to be given in the present petition.
