- Through the instant petition, filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., a prayer is made for quashing of the complaint case No.51/2016 dated 04.01.2016, titled 'Narinder Singh vs. Amrik Singh' under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, as well as the summoning order dated 17.09.2016, passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Amritsar, and consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
- The instant petition is pending since the year 2016. The issues which are raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner, is purely disputed question of facts, which cannot be adjudicated, by this Court, under the provisions of Section 482 of Cr.P.C.
- However, this Court also does not find any illegality or any perversity in the order impugned before this Court, through the instant petition. Accordingly, the instant petition is **dismissed**, with liberty to the petitioner, to raise all such pleas, which are raised before this Court, before the learned trial Court concerned, at the appropriate stage.
