Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution for seeking parole of 45 days under Sections 3 & 4 of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 on the ground that his widowed mother is suffering from various ailments and he has to look after her.

2. There is no representation on behalf of petitioner.

3. On the other hand, learned state counsel while opposing the prayer has submitted that petitioner is involved in three more FIRs duly detailed in para No.5 of the reply dated 03.07.2023. Also submitted that in case petitioner is released on parole, he can indulge in smuggling of narcotic drugs.

4. After going through the paper-book, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose off the present petition with direction to District Magistrate, Patiala to take a final decision on the request of petitioner while taking into consideration the report dated 27.07.2023 (P-1) received from Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala.

5. Needless to say that in case the matter is decided against the petitioner, he shall be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under
