1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the respondent-State to expeditiously decide his representation (Annexure P-1) dated 07.03.2024, filed by him before the SSP Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. Learned counsel submits that even though a representation (Annexure P-1) was given to SSP Fatehgarh Sahib on 07.03.2024 against some members of the Panchayat, who had forged certain documents of co-villagers, however, the official respondents had been sitting over the matter and had failed to take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

3. I have heard learned counsel and perused the relevant material on record.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to satisfy this Court as to what is his locus to be seeking registration of an FIR against the members of the Panchayat. Admittedly, the alleged documents which have been forged are not the petitioner's but some co-villagers'.

In the circumstances, no ground is made out to issue directions as

prayed for.

5. Accordingly, the instant petition is hereby dismissed.
