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**AMARJOT BHATTI J.**

1. Petitioner Vishal Chawla has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0010 dated 03.03.2024, under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Garhdiwala, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arisen therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 02.04.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. Facts of the case are that Darshveer Singh complainant gave his statement that he is working in Water Supply Department at village Godpur. On 29.02.2024, at about 6:50 PM, he was going to purchase household articles from his village Rana to Garhdiwala. When, he was going to Nawi Abadi Baba Balak Nath Mohalla, main road, a Swift Dzire car bearing No.PB-12-AF-8948 came from the wrong side and hit his motorcycle No.PB-21-C-2646 make CT 100. He fell down on the road and received injuries and his motorcycle was also damaged. Driver of the

car managed to escape. He was taken to Civil Hospital Dasuya for treatment. With these allegations, present FIR has been registered.

3. Learned counsel representing State has filed status report, which is taken on record. Mr. Arjun Veer Sharma, Advocate filed power of attorney on behalf of respondent No.2, which is taken on record.

4. Petitioner filed this petition for quashing of aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise. Petitioner and respondent No.2 were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording their statements on the basis of compromise. Detailed report regarding compromise has been received from the court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dasuya dated 15.05.2024. Statement of respondent No.2 has been recorded, where he confirmed the compromise with petitioner. He confirmed that this compromise has been effected without any pressure, coercion or undue influence from any side and he has no objection regarding quashing of FIR.

5. Petitioner – Vishal Chawla also confirmed this fact in his statement. Statement of ASI Balwinder Singh is also recorded. He confirmed that the accused is not involved or declared as proclaimed offender in any other criminal case.

6. Therefore, from the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dasuya, it is clear that compromise has been effected between parties without any pressure, coercion or undue influence, which is acceptable to both the parties.

7. Considering all these factors in mind, in the case in hand both parties have mutually settled their dispute. It would enable them to live in peace and harmony and end all litigation started between them. Thus no

purpose would be served with the continuation of criminal proceedings.

8. Therefore considering these facts, petition filed by petitioner is accepted and FIR No.0010 dated 03.03.2024, under Sections 279, 337, 338, 427 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Garhdiwala, District Hoshiarpur and all other subsequent proceedings arisen therefrom are quashed qua petitioner.

9. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
