DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

1. Fresh power of attorney on behalf of petitioner has been filed.
2. In compliance of the order dated 07.11.2023, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the attested copies of the statements of the complainant as well as the injured, besides the copy of MLR. These are taken on record.
3. The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.228 dated 19.09.2021 registered under Sections 307, 324 of the IPC registered at Police Station City, Phagwara District Kapurthala.
4. As per prosecution allegations, in an occurrence which took place on 18.09.2021, petitioner gave knife blows to Abhishek. FIR has been lodged on the basis of complaint made by his mother.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is in

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custody for the last more than 02 years 04 months; that material witnesses have already been examined; that further trial may take time to conclude and so, he be allowed bail.

6. Learned State counsel does not dispute the fact that injured of the case as well as the complainant have already been examined. Custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel reveals that petitioner is in custody for the last 02 years 04 months and 16 days with no other criminal case pending against him.

7. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances, particularly the custody period of the petitioner and the fact that material witnesses have already been examined, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
