1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.6 to 10, who are extending threats to the petitioner and further directing respondents No.4 and 5 not to interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions could be issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into representation dated 16.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps at the earliest to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajiv Vij, Addl. P.P., U.T. Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the restricted prayer made by learned counsel

for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representation dated 16.04.2024 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps, if any required, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, in accordance with law.
