RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 30.10.1998 passed in CWP-1806-1998.
2. Compliance report by way of an affidavit has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner today in the Court.
3. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 30.10.1998 passed in CWP-1806-1998 has been complied with and record of the petitioner has been attached with Sparsh and PPO number has also been allotted.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
