This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to conduct fair investigation in FIR No. 149 dated 8.09.2023 registered under Sections 323/324/506/148/149 IPC at P.S. Shahkot, District Jalandhar (Rural).

The said direction is actually misdirected since it is respondents No.3 alone who requires to be addressed and on that account the State was called upon vide order dated 25.04.2024 to inform how the investigation is progressing.

In compliance thereto, status report by way of affidavit of Ankur Gupta, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4, the same is taken on record. Copy of the same has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

After having perused the same and hearing the submissions of learned counsel for the parties, it is evident that the Investigating Agency has requested the Medical Board on 13.05.2024 to examine the entire record which has in return called upon the investigating officer to provide fresh city scan of Komalpreet Singh for comparison, along with the previous city scan reports to ascertain correct nature and intensity of the injuries suffered particularly injury No.1 to the victim Komalpreet Singh.

This Court is satisfied with the response filed by the State Counsel by way of present affidavit wherein necessary steps along with precautions are being taken to conclude the investigation in the instant FIR.

In view of the settled law and this Court being sanguine of its jurisdiction that it has no business to direct the investigating agency to conduct the investigation in a particular manner or direction, it believes to the wisdom of the investigating agency to conclude the same expecting it to do it in a time bound manner preferably within a period of another two months from today and to submit the final report of the investigation before the competent Court as per law.

Since the petition does not call for any further interference, the same is disposed of.
