1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to sit for the final exams for the MBA International Business (Final year).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he wishes to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to move an application in CWP-8482-2024 as he does not wish to press his prayer for challenge to Clause 3.2 of Academic Regulations of the University of MBA Course and only wishes to challenge the order dated 16.04.2024.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to move an application in CWP-8482-2024 decided on 18.04.2024.
