The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.80 dated 21.07.2021, under Sections 294, 386, 451, 506 and 149 of the IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar.

This Court vide order dated 03.05.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to the order dated 03.05.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from investigating officer, does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.
