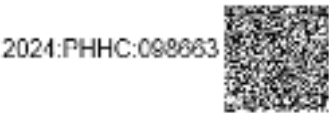

Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the orders dated 26.02.2014 (Annexure P-9) and order dated 09.04.2014 (Annexure P-10). Further prayer has been made to issue direction to the respondents to release full pay to the petitioner for the period of suspension along with interest @ 9% per annum from the date of retirement till date of payment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had sought adjournment on 21.11.2023 for impleading the legal representatives of the petitioner, who died during the pendency of the present writ petition.

Again adjournment was sought on 11.03.2024 for the same purpose, however, legal representatives of the petitioner have not been brought on record.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions from the legal representatives of the petitioner.

In this view of the matter, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

However, liberty is granted to the legal representatives of the petitioner to pursue the matter if any cause still survives.
