1. Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to conclude the partition proceedings bearing case No.14-A/TEH dated 02.02.2021 pending in the Court of respondent No.2 in a time bound manner as the same are pending since long, especially in view of Sections 111-A/ 118-A of the Haryana Land Revenue Act, 1887, whereby the partition proceedings are required to be concluded within a period of six months from the date of partition proceedings.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the partition application is pending before respondent No.2 since long and no decision thereon has been taken. He has further prayed that respondent No.2 be directed to conclude the partition proceedings in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Heard.

6. After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent

No.2 to conclude the partition proceedings pending before him expeditiously within a period of six months from the date of receipt of copy of this order, in case there is no legal impediment in the present case. Learned Collector is free to take into consideration the stay, if any granted by any higher authority/Court in the present case and proceed further in accordance with law.
