1. Present writ petition has been filed by the minor seeking the pensionary benefits in respect of the service rendered by his late father Roshan Lal.

2. Parties were relegated to the Mediation Centre of this Court and as per the report of the Mediator dated 27.05.2024, the parties have already settled their dispute amicably.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.5 submits that in pursuance to the said settlement, a sum of Rs.4,23,468/- by way of Cheque No.082603 dated 29.07.2024 drawn in favour of Bank of India is being paid to the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has accepted the cheque for onward transmission to the petitioner.
5. Learned counsel for respondent No.5 further submits that other terms and conditions of the amicable settlement will be complied with without fail and whatever amount is due to be given to the petitioner under the said settlement, will be paid to him as agreed between the parties.
6. Learned State counsel submits that whatever dues are admissible to the legal heir of the deceased Roshan Lal, the same will be released by keeping in mind the settlement between the parties.
7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
