1. In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioners is that petitioners are entitled for promotion to the post of Kanungo with effect from the date employee juniors to them were promoted to the said post and also grant them the first ACP on completion of 8 years of service, which benefits have not been extended to the petitioners and that too without any valid justification.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the representations (Annexure P-6) but the same are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.



4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representations (Annexure P-6) have been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that certain facts have come to the knowledge of the petitioners after filing the representations (Annexure P-6), hence, petitioners be given liberty to supplement the representations which will be done within a period of two weeks from today.

8. Petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
