The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.

seeking anticipatory bail in FIR mentioned below:-

2. Vide order dated 27.04.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioners were released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. Though it is submitted by learned counsel for respondent no.2 that she requires some more time to get settled in her matrimonial home in terms of settlement arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and

Conciliation Centre, however, since the petitioners have already joined the

investigations and a settlement in writing has already been executed between them and more so petitioner no.1 and respondent no.2 are residing together, therefore, I see no reason to grant any further adjournment.

4. In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 27.04.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
