1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner got lodged FIR Annexure P-1 against respondents No.5 to 10 and the said persons are now extending threats to the petitioner. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a time bound direction is given to the official respondents to consider and decide representation 02.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) given by petitioner in this regard.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that respondents No.5 to 10 who are accused in FIR Annexure P-1 were arrested and are presently lodged in jail. The State counsel further submits that in case any complaint/representation(s) has been filed, the concerned authorities will consider and decide the same as per law.
