The petitioner has filed the present Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, who is a witness in case FIR No.93 dated 09.06.2020 registered under Section 302 of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.
2. A reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sunam, District Sangrur has been filed on behalf of the respondents No.1 and 2 and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned State counsel submits that in the present case, on 17.02.2024, the petitioner has already been examined as a prosecution witness. He submits that Harmanpreet Singh tried to threaten the petitioner and keeping in view the apprehension of breach of peace, preventive action under Sections 107 and 151 IPC has already been initiated against Harmanpreet Singh. He further submits that in case the petitioner is still

threatened by any other person, he shall be at liberty to move a representation in this regard to the police authorities and necessary action shall be taken in accordance with law.

4. In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further orders are required and the present petition is accordingly disposed off.
