The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C.

seeking anticipatory bail in FIR mentioned below:-

163	22.05.2021	Police Station Narwana Sadar, District Jind	Sections 354-D, 509, 34 of IPC and Section 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act & Section 67-A of IT Act (Sections 3 & 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act were deleted on 10.06.2021)

2. Vide order dated 13.12.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

3. It is admitted by the learned State counsel that the petitioner has joined and rejoined the investigation in pursuance of order passed by this

Court from time to time. His custodial interrogation is not required and no recovery is to be effected from him since the mobile phone which was allegedly used by him stands recovered from him.

5. In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 13.12.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
