1. Prayer made in the present petition is for quashing the order dated 16.05.2018 (Annexure P-3), whereby the petitioner who rendered 17 years of service, was dismissed from job.
2. Learned counsel submits that the circumstances have now undergone to a tremendous change inasmuch as the petitioner has since passed away and his family is unable to sustain itself. The grounds raised in the appeal (Annexure P-6) were detailed referring to the receipt of cash awards etc. at one point of time, as also the medical opinions, with a prayer made therein to take a lenient view for his wife and minor children and the fact that he had devoted his time for the service to the nation, to which had not been duly given consideration by the Appellate Authority. As such, his LRs may be granted liberty to file supplementary grounds as

also cite judgments for the purpose of pension, to the respondents, which may be directed to be considered sympathetically in a time bound manner, to that limited prayer, learned counsel for the respondents has no objection.

3. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case, the needful is done by the LRs of the petitioner within four weeks, speaking order after granting opportunity of hearing to the concerned, shall be passed within four months, in accordance with law.
