1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari, quashing the circular No.6/93 bearing office order No.289/Fin. Dated 05.02.1993 (Annexure P-6).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that during the pendency of the present petition, petitioner No.1 has unfortunately died and despite his best efforts he has not been able to get instructions from LRs of petitioner No.1 and from petitioner No.2.
3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the LRs of petitioner No.1 and petitioner No.2 to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
