Challenge in the present writ petition is for quashing of notice/challan dated 12.12.2019 (Annexure P-4) and dated 14.02.2020 (Annexure P-8) whereby demand had been raised pursuant to the theft of energy.

Written statement had been filed on behalf of the respondents in January, 2021, wherein it was stated that on both the occasions, the assessed charges/penalty had already been deposited by the petitioner.

It is noticed by this Court that on four occasions when the matter was taken up since 15.03.2023, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on three occasions and on the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner appeared and sought adjournment on the pretext that the arguing counsel is in personal difficulty.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today as well nor any request has been made. It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
