This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the private respondents.

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of the private respondents, the petitioner had moved a representation dated 20.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) to the Station House Officer, Madlauda, District Panipat, but no action has been taken thereon.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to consider and

dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents No. 1 to 3.
6. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the aforesaid representation will be decided in accordance with the law by the appropriate authority.
7. Taking into consideration the respective submissions and the specific prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-the Superintendent of Police, Panipat, Office at Mini Secretariat, District Panipat, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 20.04.2024 (Annexure P-4), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
9. Disposed of.
