1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is mother of respondent No.4. It is further submitted that respondent No.4, respondent No.5 who is wife of respondent No.4, respondent No.7 who is son of respondent No.4 and respondent No.6 who is cousin of respondent No.7 are unnecessarily harassing the petitioner. They intend to grab her property and they are also extending threats to cause physical harm to the petitioner and in this regard, representation dated 21.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) is given to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action on the same. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide representation (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and submitted that in case any complaint/representation(s) has been filed, the concerned authorities will consider and decide the same as per law.

4. Counsel for the petitioner is agreed to the aforesaid proposal.
5. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation 21.03.2024 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
