MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.30 dated 13.02.2024 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional (Regulations) Act, 2014, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

2. On 07.05.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Contents that there is no allegation that petitioner has received any money from either of the victim(s) or complainant(s), rather nominated merely on the premise that he is brother of main accused-Amit Tuli. Also contends that petitioner is ready to deposit alleged amount of Rs. 8,51,500/- before the Court of competent jurisdiction subject to final outcome of FIR”

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3. Thereafter, on 02.07.2024, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time to deposit the amount of Rs.8,51,500/- before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 07.05.2024/02.07.2024, the petitioner has deposited an amount of Rs.8,51,500/- before the Court of competent jurisdiction which fact has not been disputed by the learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Banarasi Dass.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Banarasi Dass, has further submitted that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

6. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 07.05.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS/438 of the Cr.P.C.
