1. Through the instant petition, under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer is made for quashing of the order dated 02.07.2008 (Annexure P-4), passed in case FIR No.136 dated 06.09.2007, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1).
2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 16.07.2024, the following order was passed:-

"On the last date of hearing i.e. 18.09.2023, none has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner. Today also there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Purely, in the interest of justice, adjourned to 13.08.2024.

To be shown in the urgent list.

It is made clear that in case the learned counsel for the petitioner does not cause appearance on the next date of hearing, then this Court would decided the instant matter on its own merits.
3. The instant petition is pending since 2017, and for the last so many dates of hearing, either there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, or

there is a request for adjournment on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner on one pretext or the other. Even today also, no one has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner, despite specific directions issued on the last date of hearing (supra), this Court can safely conclude that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present petition.

4. Therefore, the instant petition is **dismissed** for non-prosecution.
