SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. This petition has been moved for setting aside recovery notices (Annexures P-2 to P-6) issued to the petitioners pursuant to the directions issued by the National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, while disposing of IA No.332 of 2019 in OA No.465 of 2019.

2. The record of this petition reveals that an appeal (Annexure P-8) has been moved by all the petitioners herein, before the National Green Tribunal, the fate whereof is not known to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. This Court has it's own doubts as to whether an appeal against the order of National Green Tribunal would lie in National Green Tribunal.

The proper remedy as per the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010, is before



the Apex Court.

4. However, since the impugned recovery notices have been issued pursuant to an order of the National Green Tribunal, which have either not been challenge by the petitioners in the proper forum or has not been interfered with by any of the higher forum, this Court declines to interfere in the said matter and dismisses the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail remedy as per law.
5. The present petition stands dismissed with liberty aforesaid.
