**SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)**

This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 for providing security of life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members from the hands of respondents Nos.4 to 6 and further taking strict legal action under appropriate sections of IPC against respondents No.4 & 5 because they are continuously harassing to the petitioner as well as his family members alleging false allegations and on asking of private respondents, the respondent No.4/ASI Radhey Shayam who had kept confined the petitioner in police lock-up about 24 hours, without any case/complaint and released him after taking his signatures upon some blank papers etc. now they private respondents are still threats to the life and liberty of the petitioner in active connivance with local police.

Affidavit dated 05.09.2024 of Ms. Roopdeep Kaur, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (East), Ludhiana, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, has been filed, which is taken on record and copy of the same has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondents No.2 to look into the representations dated 20.04.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-5), within a time bound manner.

Without adverting to the merits of the case and in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representations dated 20.04.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-5) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. The order so passed shall be communicated to the petitioner within a week thereafter.
