1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No. 5 to allow the petitioners to contest the elections for the post of Panch.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petition was filed in the year 2008 and with the passage of time, the present petition in all probability has been rendered infructuous.
3. No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said arguments.
4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the same in case any cause survives.
