JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (Oral)

The prayer in the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents No.4 and 5 from harassing or interfering in their peaceful married life. They have prayed that they be provided protection by the State.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sukhdev Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Headquarters), Patiala filed today in the Court is taken on record.

While referring to the same, the learned State counsel contends that the proceedings under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C. have been initiated against respondents No. 4 and 5. Further, the petitioners have been instructed that in case they still face any danger to their life, they can contact the Police Station Kotwali, Patiala seeking help.

In view of the respective contentions of both the parties, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Needless to say, that in case the petitioners face any threat in future, they are at liberty to approach the Investigating Agency for redressal of their grievances.
