1. These cases involve similar issues and therefore, are being disposed of together by this common judgment.
2. The challenge made in the present petitions is to the orders, whereby the pay of the petitioners was reduced by one increment and recovery was being effected as also to direct the respondents to fix the pay of the petitioner as per Rule 15 of the A.C.P. Rules, 1998.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from Sunil Kumar Yadav, S.S.S. and Hans Kumar, Clerk submits that the relief claimed in the present petitions stand granted and the recovery was not effected, in view of the interim

order passed by the Division Bench of this Court dated 06.05.2005. Thus the present petitions be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

4. Ordered accordingly. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to review it, in case, any grievance still subsists.
