1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 17.11.2023 passed in CWP-25813-2023.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of the respondent has been filed today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.
3. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that order dated 17.11.2023 passed in CWP-25813-2023 has been complied with and all the retirement dues have been released to the petitioner.
