The present petition under Section 482 CrPC has been preferred by the petitioner seeking direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to ensure fair and proper investigation in case FIR No.8 dated 06.02.2024 registered under Sections 279 and 337 IPC at Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh (Annexure P-3).

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the son of the petitioner namely Krishan Lal sustained injuries in a road accident and qua the same the aforesaid FIR (Annexure P-3) was registered but till date no headway has been made in the investigation and even the accused has not been arrested. He submits that the petitioner has moved various representation, latest being Annexure P-5 dated 03.03.2024, which was received in the office of respondent No.2 on 07.03.2024, but no action thereon has been taken. He submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if directions are given to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the representation Annexure P-5 in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Viranjeet Singh, Addl. P.P. for UT Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that the representation of the petitioner will be considered and disposed of in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

5. Heard.

6. Considering the submissions and limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to consider and dispose of the representation dated 03.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner as well.
