1. The present petitioners after suffering the verdict of eviction of Annexure P/1, thus from the Court of the Assistant Collector–cum–SDM, Punhana, District Nuh, were led to institute an appeal thereagainst before the appellate authority. The said appeal (Annexure P/2), is stated to be sub judice before the appellate authority, but an application as filed within the said appeal thus for relief of staying the operation of Annexure P/1, is stated, to be not yet adjudicated. Therefore, the petitioners pray that a mandamus be passed upon the appellate authority, to lawfully consider the said application, and also to promptly pass a lawful order thereons.
2. The said made prayer is not opposed by the learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana. Consequently, the writ petition is allowed and the appellate authority is directed to, within a period of two weeks from today,

make a lawful speaking decision on the application filed within the statutory appeal, thus asking for relief for staying the operation of Annexure P/1. Till the said application is decided, thereupto the parties are directed to maintain status quo in respect of the disputed shops.

3. Moreover, the appellate authority concerned, is also directed to within a period of three months from today, make a lawful decision, upon, the statutory appeal (Annexure P/2), but after hearing all the affected persons concerned.

4. Disposed of accordingly along with all pending applications, if any.
