1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 01.05.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed in CWP-8962-2017, order dated 31.08.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed in LPA-352-2014 and order dated 30.09.2016 (Annexure P-2A) passed in CWP-2866-2014.
2. Counsel for the respondents submits that the orders qua which the contempt is alleged, have been complied with and necessary speaking order has been passed by the concerned authority.
3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
4. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-addressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
