Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the liberty given by the respondents, the petitioner had changed the category to unreserved post in the sub category of Eligible Sports Persons and despite the fact that the posts are still lying vacant, the claim of the petitioner is not being considered against those vacant posts.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 08.03.2024 (Annexure P-8) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 08.03.2024 (Annexure P-8) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the said representation will be decided by the competent authority within a period of six weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
