1.                Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to official respondents No. 2 and 3 to register an FIR under the appropriate sections of Information and Technology Act, or under the IPC on the complaint (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner .

2.                Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that grievance raised by the petitioner has been duly redressed and on the allegations levelled in the complaint made by the petitioner, FIR No. 189 dated 18.09.2020 under Sections 509, 120-B of Indian Penal Code read with Section 66-C of IT Act at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar (Rural) has been registered against (1) Sukhpreet Singh, (2) Sukhwinder Kaur and (3) Amrik Singh. Learned State counsel further submits that Investigating Agency would conclude the investigation within a period of three months and submit the final report before the jurisdictional Magistrate, strictly in accordance with law.

3. In view of the submission made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
5. Pending CRM(s), if any, are also disposed of accordingly.
